- Provide Union County College administrators, educators and advisors with actionable data about student interests and the UCC programs that align with student interests.

RESULTS

- More than 75 students completed the Career Key Discovery assessment and identified more than 34 careers that interested them.
- Students saved more than 20 college majors from UCC that matched their career interests.
- · Administrators gained valuable clarity into students' interests and majors, with the most popular career being nurse anesthetist.
- STEM majors comprised the largest number of students' majors of interest...a critical insight for UCC advisors and academic planning teams.

Union County College (UCC) was the first community college in New Jersey. From its founding in 1933 right through today and tomorrow, the College provides accessible, affordable educational opportunities to the residents of Union County and to students from 83 countries. As part of the College's commitment to its first-generation students, UCC participates in the Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF) Program.

Created by statute in 1968, EOF provides academic, financial and social support to thousands of students who have the potential to do college work, were academically under-prepared in high school and have a history of financial disadvantage. Program funding supports these benefits and services:

- Summer orientation for first year students
- Personal, academic and career advising
- Academic support through tutoring and supplemental instruction
- Leadership activities
- Financial grants
- An opportunity to join the Chi Alpha Epsilon National **Honor Society**

UCC, through its EOF program, makes Career Key Discovery available to qualifying students. Using science-based theory and best practices in career counseling, Career Key maps student personality, interests, values and skills to careers and UCC majors, so UCC students can choose and deeply explore opportunities that fit them best.

Tools Administrators Value


Career Key Central is also delivering important capabilities to the UCC administrative, counseling and student services teams through its core dashboard hub and tools for administrators:
